In lieu of flowers, memorial contributions may be directed to Harvest for Hunger.





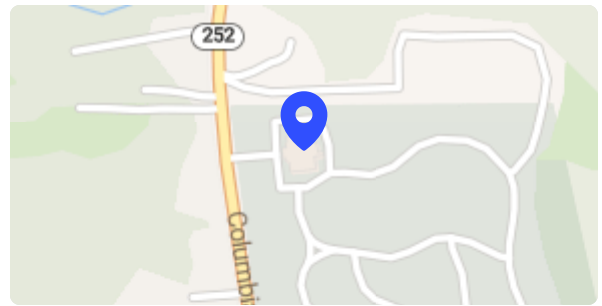
