Alex Krutowskis, 71, of Elyria, Ohio passed away on November 16, 2021 with family by his side. 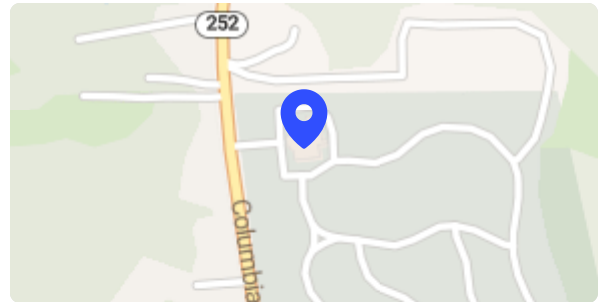

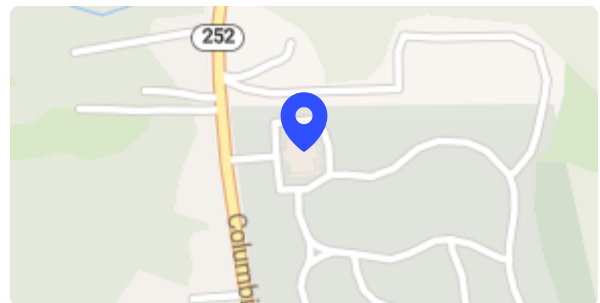
