James William Wallace, 88, of Olmsted Falls, passed away unexpectedly on October 18, 2022. He was born in Cleveland, Ohio, on October 25, 1933, to the late James G. and Jewell P. (nee Max) Wallace. James is survived by his loving wife of almost 49 years, Leanne (nee Hagen), their anniversary being next month, November 3. James was in the Army for 22 years and served in Korea and Vietnam and dedicated his life to helping veterans with his holding of several post positions with the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and the 37th Division Veterans Association where he established a scholarship endowment. 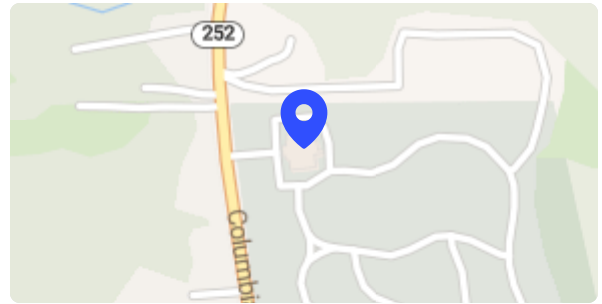

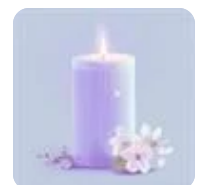
