**T**imothy D. Mikut, age 57, of North Royalton, peacefully passed away on October 3, 2023. He was born March 16, 1966, in Parma to his parents, LeRoy Mikut and Jeanne (John) Hobson.

His kind hearted nature and passion for life made him a favorite among all those he encountered. Throughout his life, Tim demonstrated an unwavering commitment to academic excellence.
