Thomas Edward Haas, age 79, passed away at home on December 9, 2024. Born on October 9, 1945 in Amherst, Ohio, he was the beloved son of Elmer and Marcella Haas.

Thomas is survived by his devoted wife of 38 years, Janet Haas (Middleton). He was a loving father to Tom (Krista) Haas, and Katie Haas, as well as a cherished grandfather to Rowan and Sloane Haas. He is also survived by his sister, Sue (Ron) Snizek, and beloved “Uncle Tommy” to many nieces and nephews. He is also survived by son, David. 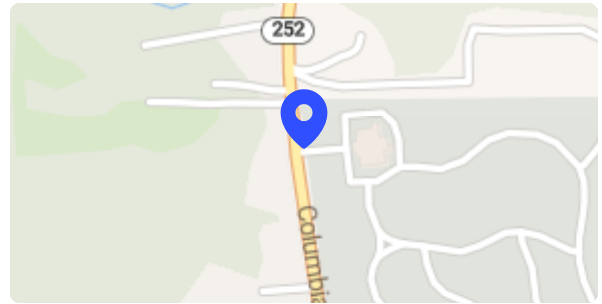

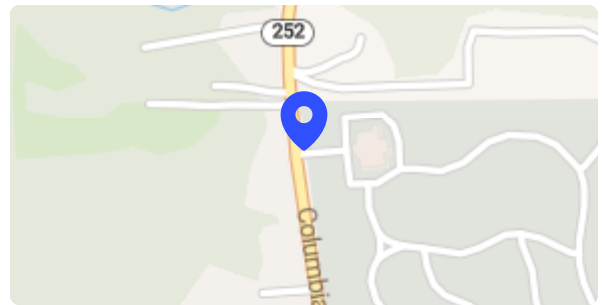
