Rasma Putnins Klipsons, aged 89, passed away peacefully on February 15, 2025. Born on October 6, 1935, in Liepaja, Latvia to Ieva Reters (née Reters) and Janis Putnins, Rasma lived a life full of love, resilience, and dedication to her family.

She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Gunars Klipsons, sister, Aina, and niece, Karen Lord. Rasma is survived by her beloved son, John N Klipsons, her cherished sister, Arija (Raymond) Lord, her devoted nieces, Ellen (Steve) Tamburello and Diane (Brian) Grant, and her great-nieces and nephews, Rachel Tamburello, Sterling (Aja) Tamburello, Spencer Tamburello, Phebe Grant, Arija Grant, and Delaney Grant. Rasma showered her love on her family, relishing in family gatherings over holidays and throughout the year. She loved to make traditional Latvian foods for these gatherings and will always be remembered for her superior pīrāgi!

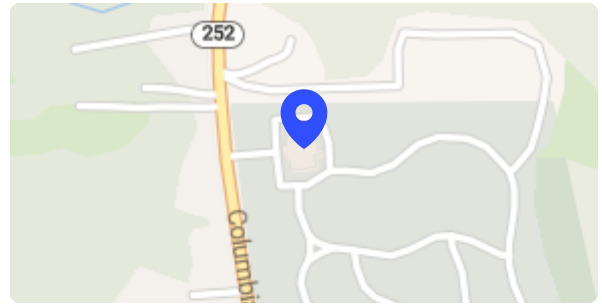

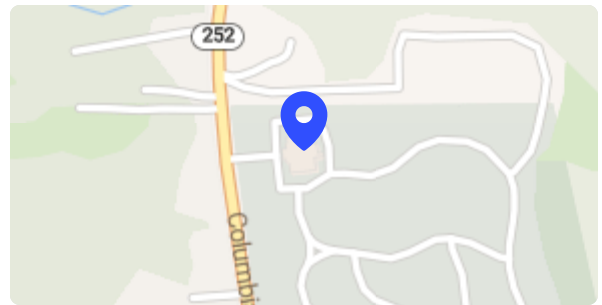
