# Michael Wood

He was a devoted husband to his late wife, Pamela Patterson (deceased 1995), a cherished partner to Chris Wolf, and a truly exceptional father to his children, Alex, James (Adrienne), and Cat. He departed this life surrounded by his loving family, including his dogs Ripley and Ruth.

A brilliant electrical engineer, Michael programmed countless machines across the spectrum of manufacturing, processing, and refinement. His enduring legacy quietly thrives in the mass production that underpins our world in ways most could never imagine. From the intricate workings of steel mills and food packaging to the precise operations of even the Taiwanese Mint, his talent and dedication profoundly influenced the modern world. 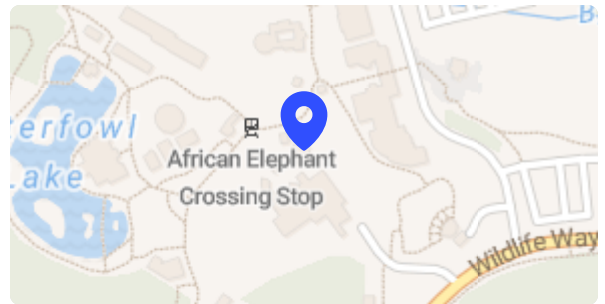
