The family will be having private memorial services. Interment will be at Sunset Memorial Park Cemetery in North Olmsted, Ohio.

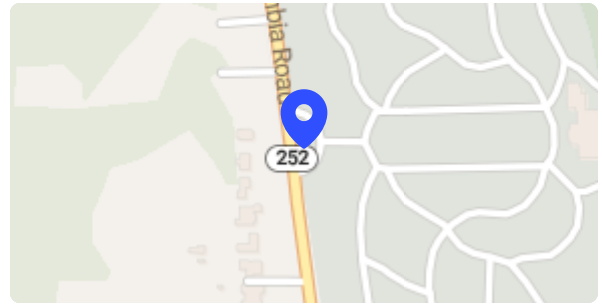

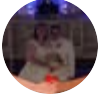
