We are heartbroken to announce the passing of Doris Ann Wheeler (nee Suszkowski), 82, of Rocky River Ohio. Doris passed away on the morning of June 16th, 2025 after a lengthy battle with heart disease.

Doris, the oldest child of John Joseph and Doris Marie Suszkowski (nee Trotter), was born on the 13th of June 1943 in Cleveland Ohio. Doris attended John Adams HS and studied at Fenn College. 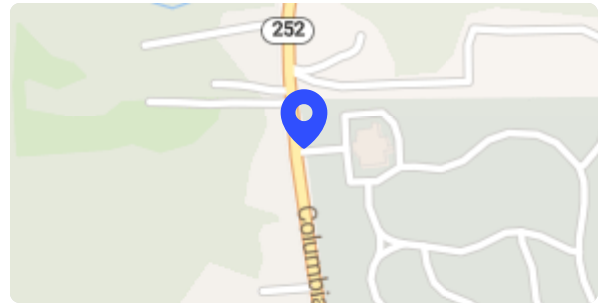

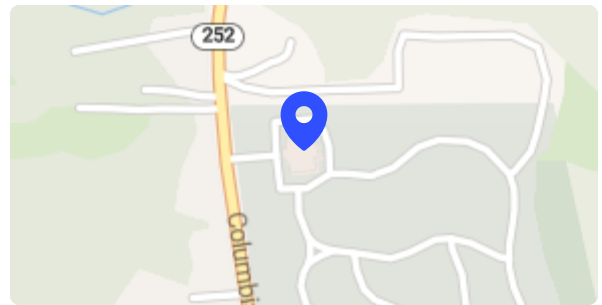
