In lieu of flowers, the family kindly requests donations in Phillip's memory to the Thomas P. Perciak Family Hospice in Strongsville.

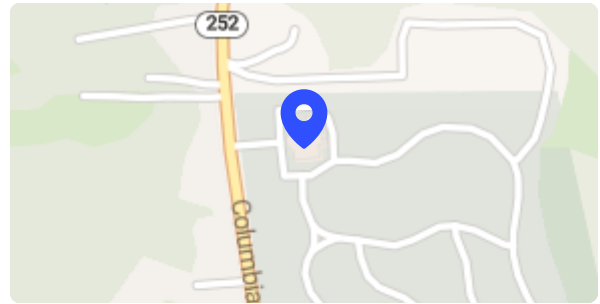
