# Jon Edward Spiker

**J**on Edward Spiker, age 66, of North Royalton, Ohio, passed away peacefully on August 24, 2025. Born on July 15, 1959, to Edna and the late John Spiker, Jon lived a life marked by his love of the Lord, his devotion and love to his family, and his gratitude for his friendships.

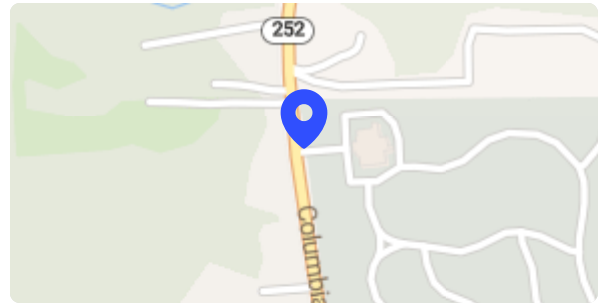

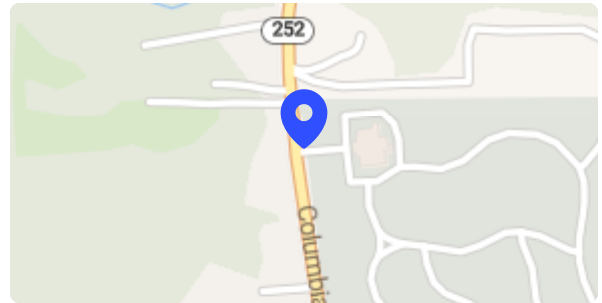

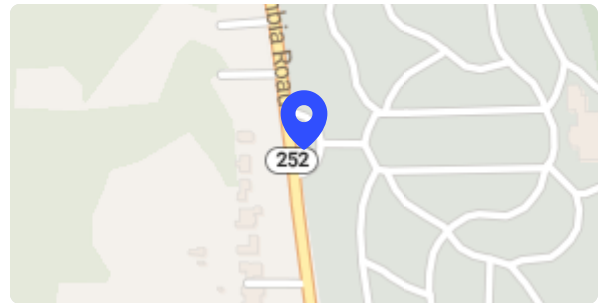
