He cheerfully went up and down a total of eight flights on each trip, over and over. Years later when I moved out, all my other roommates had left me with the heavy furniture to move on my own, yet he was the only one who showed up to help besides my brother and dad. Up and down, up and down. Over and over. He told me when he was admitted for treatment that they asked for his medical history. Jeremy was the healthiest, most active guy, and the only injury he said he ever had to have treated was for when he sprained his ankle moving – amongst other things – my solid wood radio console that fall. Yet he still kept going that day, even though he was hurt. That's the kind of guy Jeremy was. He always gave, he never took. And always with a smile on his face. I'll remember that forever.
