AUG 14, 1928 - FEB 27, 2026

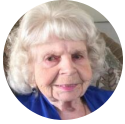
**K**ay Phillips, age 97, passed away on February 27, 2026. She was born on August 14, 1928 to the late Peter and Vesta Golobosky.

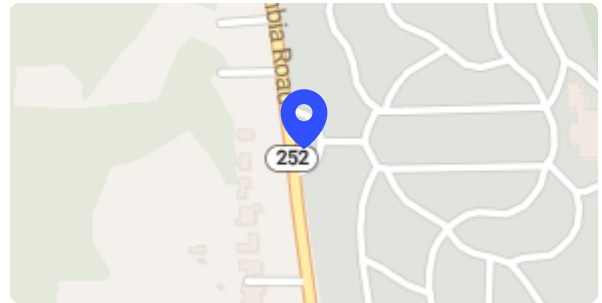
